### THOUGHTFUL MOMENTS WITH GOD

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

"The best devotional book for children is to read from the Bible."

The idea of "relationship" falls short of the Biblical truth. It is not we who initiate a relationship with Christ, but He initiates such with us. (John 15:4, 5, 16; Luke 15:4-10).

A devotional program is not do-it-yourself "works"; the Holy Spirit does the wooing, we do the responding (Isaiah 50:4, 5; 30:21).

Tell your child that the Holy Spirit has already been given to him, for what Jesus says is true (John 14:16). Don't take that "Comforter" away!

Assurance of salvation is not the issue in these last days; the true issue is the honor and vindication of Christ (Romans 3:3.4, 23, 24; 5:16-18; Revelation 14:6, 7; 19:6-8).

Many early morning problems will be automatically solved when we find something better to think about at night than the "late late show" (each new day begins at sunset! Genesis 1, etc.

However hurried or however late you are, pray unhurriedly with your children. Let them hear your voice; and don't be afraid if sometimes the tears come.

Family worship in an atmosphere of resentment or impatience is a disaster. The solution is not to cut out the worship, but solve the problem. An unhurried prayer can be a brief one! God help us never to utter a thoughtless prayer. Think first.

The best devotional book for children is to read from the Bible. Take great care in what translation you use. Before you read any passage, be sure you see the Good News in it. If you don't see it, you will very likely communicate Bad News in the way you read the pas-

sage, and that Bad News is the source of all our problems. The ancient Jews read the Bible with a *veil* over their heart and missed the Good News (2 Corinthians 3:14).



Don't pray unnecessary prayers—they communicate legalism. Example: you don't need to pray that the Lord will make the sun rise tomorrow. Neither need you ask Him to "help" little Junior be a good boy, etc. The Saviour is already helping him. The child desperately needs to learn the Good News and believe it, and then he will be a good boy.

Both parents should initiate and support fam-

ily worship, but if only one wishes to pray with your child, do it. Never let the child get the impression that the uncooperating parent is "outside" the family of God, etc., but that he or she does not yet see its importance. In the thinking of the child, don't draw a circle to shut the other spouse out, draw a circle to draw him or her in (Luke 15:1-4; Galatians 4:1-3).

If there is tension or disunity in your home, your greatest danger is that you unconsciously yield to the temptation of unbelief. Instead of blaming your spouse for your problems, get on your knees and ask the dear Lord to show you where you may be making the problem worse. Then be straight-forward, honest, and humble, even to the point of self being crucified with Christ. A resurrection is sure to follow the cross, but you may not see it now.
